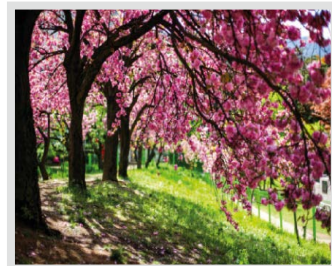

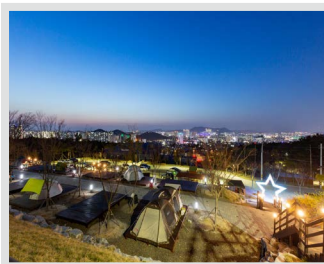

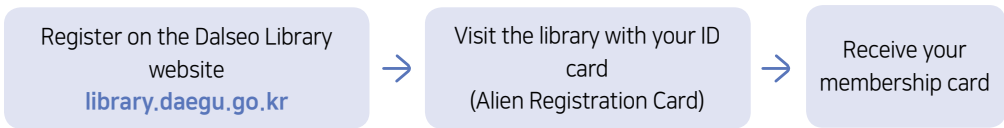

- **General members** : 10 books for 15 days per library (including the day of borrowing)
- **Multi-child family members** : 20 books for 20 days per library (including the day of borrowing)
- **Members with disabilities or elderly members** : 10 books for 30 days per library (including the day of borrowing)
- **Group check-out** : 100 books or less for 30 days per group (including the day of borrowing)

Membership Registration Process

- **Eligibility** : Residents of Daegu (including Gyeongsan and Chilgok), students, and workers
- **How to Join**



- **Required Documents** : Domestic Residence Certificate or Alien Registration Card
 - ※ The length of stay must be at least 3 months remaining
 - ※ Under 14 years old : Legal guardian's ID card and Certificate of Foreign Resident Registration to verify the relationship with the guardian
 - ※ 14 to 18 years old : Youth card or student ID, and Certificate of Foreign Resident Registration(for Address Verification)

Reissuing Membership Card

- If you lose your membership card, report it to the library by phone or in person.
- After 5 days from the report date, reissue will be processed after ID verification.

Guidelines for Various Reports



Foreigner Registration

※ Online reservation is mandatory before visiting (www.hikorea.go.kr)

※ For required documents, please contact ☎1345 (Immigration Contact Center). Additional documents may be required during the review process.

▪ Registration Target

- Foreigners who intend to stay in South Korea for more than 90 days from the date of entry
- Foreigners who have lost their South Korean nationality and acquired foreign nationality, or who were born in South Korea, and wish to stay for more than 90 days from the date their residency status is granted.

▪ Registration Timing

Foreigners who entered South Korea, or those who were granted or changed their residency status, must register within 90 days from the entry date or from the date of the residency status approval.

▪ Required Documents

Passport, one color photo (3.5cm x 4.5cm), documents for the specific residency status, a cash fee of 35,000 KRW

▪ Application Method

Visit the relevant Immigration Office to submit your foreign registration application and receive your alien registration card.

Change of Address Report

▪ Target

- Foreigners who have completed foreign registration and wish to change their address.

▪ Required Documents

Report within 15 days from the date of moving to the new address.

▪ How to Report

- In-person report (at the relevant immigration office or the local Administrative Welfare Center of the residence area)
- Online report (through HiKorea electronic civil service)

▪ Reporting Obligation

Passport, Alien Registration Card, proof of residence (e.g., real estate contract)

※ Proof of residence documents may vary depending on the type of address, so please contact the Immigration Office or the Administrative Welfare Center for more information.

K-point E-7-4 System



※ Added "K-point E-7-4 system": A system that allows foreigners who are currently in Korea as simple skilled workers (E-9 visa, etc.) to upgrade to E-7-4 (skilled worker) when they reach a certain number of points by converting their experience, skills, language skills, etc. into points.

Eligibility Requirements (Must meet all of the following conditions)

- Foreign nationals who have stayed in Korea for over 4 years with an E-9, E-10, or H-2 visa within the last 10 years and are currently working at their workplace
- Employment contract with the current employer for a salary of 26,000,000 KRW or more, with the commitment to work for at least the next 2 years
- Recommendation from the company where the applicant has been employed for at least 1 year (company recommendation is mandatory)
- Minimum scores for the average income and Korean language proficiency, each with a minimum score of 50 points, for a total of at least 200 points (including bonus points) out of 300 points

Scoring Criteria

- Average income (average annual income over the last 2 years)** : Maximum 120 point

Application Schedule

- From March 1, 2025 (Saturday) to December 31, 2025 (Wednesday)**
continuous application acceptance until the quota is filled

Application Method

- Online application through HiKorea(www.hikorea.go.kr) electronic civil service
 ※ (Application on a 5-day cycle) The application day is designated based on the last digit of the applicant's birth year
 ※ (e.g., Born in 1990 → Friday, Born in 1993 → Wednesday, Born in 1987 → Tuesday)

Family Relations Registration System

Marriage Registration

- **Target** : Foreigners married to Korean spouses
- **Required Documents** : Marriage registration form (1 copy), Korean spouse's ID, foreign spouse's passport or alien registration card, national ID of the home country, relevant documents, seal, etc
※ For foreigners, documents such as proof of marriage establishment and translation, nationality certificate, etc., may vary by country, so it is essential to call and inquire before registering
- **Registration Period** : None (However, for marriages conducted according to foreign practices, it must be done within 3 months from the marriage establishment date.)
- **Submission Location** : Local district offices (city, county, or town halls) nationwide

Birth Registration

- **Target** : Children born to a Korean and a foreigner
- **Required Documents** : Birth registration form (1 copy), birth certificate (from hospital), ID, seal, etc.
※ For children with dual nationality, the child's passport should be presented.
- **Registration Period** : Within 1 month of birth
- **Registrant** : Father or mother
- **Submission Location** : The Administrative Welfare Center in the area where the child registered or local district offices (city, county, or town halls) nationwide

Death Registration

- **Target** : Foreign family members registered in the Korean family relations registration system
- **Required Documents** : Death registration form (1 copy), death certificate (or autopsy report), ID, seal, etc
- **Registration Period** : Within 1 month from the date the death was confirmed
- **Registrant** : Co-habiting relatives, non-co-habiting relatives, co-habitants, others (such as facility managers, or administrators of the place of death)
- **Submission Location** : Local district offices (city, county, or town halls) nationwide

Foreigners' Seal Registration and Certificate Issuance

Seal Registration

- **Eligibility** : Registered foreigners who have stayed in South Korea for more than 90 days according to the Immigration Control Act
- **Method** : Visit the local Administrative Welfare Center of the residence area
- **Required Documents** : Alien registration card, permanent resident card, or certificate of domestic residence registration, passport, and seal to be used for the official stamp

Seal Change

- **Target** : Foreigners or foreign nationals of Korean origin with reported domestic residence who have changed their names
- **Method** : Visit the local Administrative Welfare Center of the residence area
- **Content** : Change the seal to match the newly changed name

Seal Certificate Issuance

- **Location** : Administrative Welfare Centers in all cities, towns, and districts nationwide, Dalseo-gu General Civil Affairs Division
- **Content** : VAAfter verifying identity with the alien registration card, permanent resident card, or domestic residence registration certificate, a seal certificate will be issued



- ※ Alien registration cards, permanent resident cards, and domestic residence registration certificates that have expired will not be accepted
- ※ If submitting a certificate of fact without an alien registration card or domestic residence registration certificate, the passport must also be presented

Guidelines for Welfare and Education Systems



National Health Insurance System Guide

- **Eligibility** : Automatic enrollment after 6 months from the initial entry date
- **Procedure** : Processed automatically by the National Health Insurance Service
 - ※ After automatic enrollment, health insurance card, notification of acquisition, and billing statement will be sent (A notification of the upcoming enrollment will be sent 4 months after the initial entry date.)
- **Benefits** : Health insurance benefits, including hospitalization, outpatient treatment, and national health check-ups, just like Korean citizens, from the enrollment date
 - ※ If health insurance premiums are unpaid, health insurance benefits will be limited when using medical services
- **Inquiries** : ☎ 1577-1000 (Press 6 for foreign language services)
 - ☎ 033-811-2000 (Support available for English, Chinese, Vietnamese, and Uzbek consultations)

National Health Insurance System Guide

- **Eligibility** : Foreigners (including those who have been issued a temporary management number)
 - ※ Foreigners without an alien registration number can visit a public health center with supporting documents to receive a temporary management number before getting vaccinated
- **Support Details** : Full coverage of vaccination costs

Emergency Relief Fund for Foreign Residents

- **Eligibility** : Foreign residents residing in Dalseo-gu who are experiencing temporary financial hardship due to illness, disaster, calamity, unemployment, etc.
- **Application Method** : Apply at the local Administrative Welfare Center or foreign resident support organization in your area of residence.
- **Required Documents** : Identification (passport or alien registration card), proof of temporary financial hardship, bank account copy, etc
- **Amount of Support** : 500,000 KRW per household
- **Contact** : Dalseo-gu General Civil Affairs Division(☎ 053-667-2264)

Crisis Support Program for Multicultural Families

- **Eligibility** : Multicultural families residing in Daegu with an income level within 100% of the median household income.
- **Application Method** : Apply at the local Administrative Welfare Center in your area of residence.
- **Required Documents** : Identification (passport or alien registration card), proof of crisis situation, health insurance premium payment confirmation, bank account copy, etc.
- **Amount of Support** : Support up to 1.8 million KRW per household (for living expenses and medical costs).

Childcare Fee Support for Foreign Children

- **Project Period** : March 2025 – February 2026
- **Eligibility**
 - Foreign children (ages 0-2) attending daycare centers in Dalseo-gu
 - Children of foreign guardians who have been residing in Dalseo-gu for more than 3 months (over 90 days)
 - ※ Both the child and guardian must be within their legal stay period (excluding illegal residents and undocumented individuals)
- **Support Amount** : 70% of the childcare fee for children aged 0-2

Guidelines for Household Waste Disposal



- **Disposal Time** : 8:00 PM to 2:00 AM
- **Disposal Location** : In front of your house (or store), designated areas within apartment complexes
- **Important Notice** : A fine of up to 100,000 KRW will be imposed for illegal dumping
- **Disposal Methods by Waste Type**
 - 1 **General Waste**
 - Place in a volume-based garbage bag and tie it up for disposal
 - Collection days : Monday to Saturday
 - ※ Volume-based garbage bags can be purchased at nearby supermarkets or convenience stores

2 bulky waste

Safety Guidelines for Personal Mobility Devices (PM)

What is needed

A driver's license and helmet are essential!

To ride a personal mobility device, you must have a driver's license for at least a "moped / motorized bicycle" or higher.

In case of an unexpected accident, make sure to wear safety gear to protect yourself.



What you should not do

Drunk driving is prohibited!

Personal mobility devices are classified as "vehicles," so if you ride under the influence, you will be punished for "drunk driving."



What you should not do

Exceeding the passenger limit is prohibited!

The passenger limit for electric quickboards (electric scooters) and electric two-wheeled vehicles is 1 person.



The passenger limit for electric bicycles is 2 people.

What is needed

Use the road properly!

Personal mobility devices can be ridden on bicycle lanes or the right edge of the roadway.



It is generally prohibited to use sidewalks, and on crosswalks, you must dismount and walk the device. (It is allowed to ride on bicycle crosswalks.)

Correct Right Turn Method at Intersections

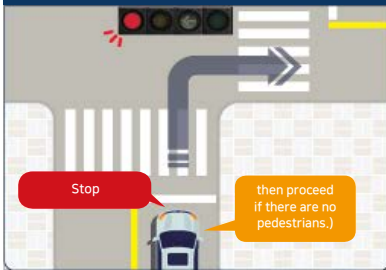
Easy-to-understand right turns



According to the revised traffic regulations, vehicles must stop when the traffic light is red.

Turn right after **stopping** at the **red light**.

When the front signal is **red**, you **must stop**, then turn. **After stopping**, if there are no pedestrians crossing, you may make the right turn at a **slow speed**.



When there is a right-turn signal with a **green arrow**, you may turn right. (Right turns are not allowed when the **light is red**.)



Important Steps for Making a Right Turn

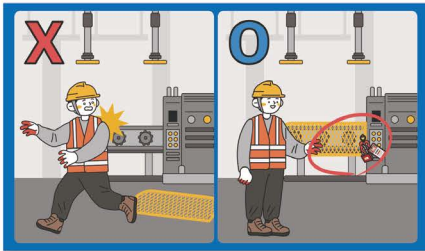

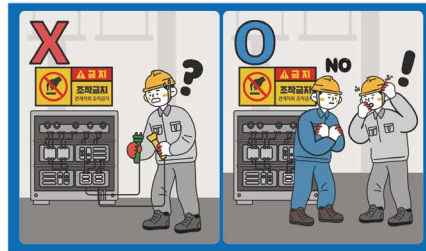

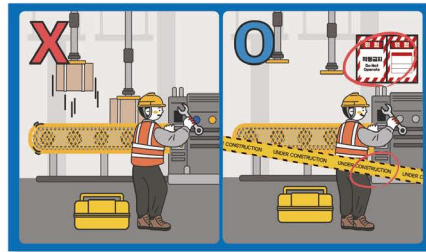
